Mr & Mrs Caspersonn



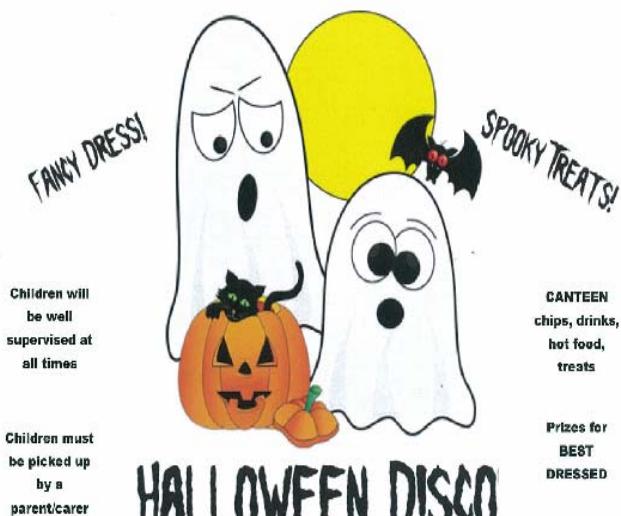
Hay was very lucky to secure Mr & Mrs Caspersonn as residents of our little town. They have thrown themselves into our community with gusto.

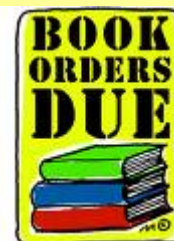
