#### **Principal's Report Grandparents' Day**

Grandparents have a unique role. They don't just connect us to the values, stories and histories of our families, but to the values, stories and histories of our communities. In 2011 the State Government chose to recognise the contributions that grandparents make by launching Grandparents' Day. Each year, Grandparents' Day is celebrated in NSW on the last Sunday of October. The students in Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 at Hay Public School participated in Grandparents' Day activities last Friday. The celebrations began with morning tea at 10:30 am under the K-2 Shelter. Students were asked to bring a small plate of goodies to share for morning tea. 
#### Junior Cricket Coaching Clinic Saturday Nov 17th
