Principal's Report

Parliamentarian Nominations

Nominations will shortly be called for Parliamentarians in 2013. Students in Year 5 are able to nominate themselves or others if they feel they have the necessary qualities to make a good school leader. Students who have been on a monitoring card or received a suspension this year are ineligible to nominate. Nomination forms can be collected next week from Mrs Dunn at the front office and are to be handed in to Mrs Oatway by Friday 16th November. The announcement of successful nominees will occur on Monday 26th November.

Student leaders have important roles to play both at school and in the community:

- They set high standards of behaviour and attitude to school for other students;
- They lead and report to school assemblies and school events;
- School captains and vice captains lead the school parliament;

- School captains and vice captains welcome official visitors to the school and are often called on to give a vote of thanks to visitors or people who address or perform for the students;

School captains and vice captains are often called on to represent the school at public functions as well as events in the community. eg Anzac Day, Remembrance Day, Shire Council meetings, etc; and

- Student leaders are ambassadors for the school at all times, representing the whole school community – students, principal, teachers, staff, parents and members of the community.

Assessment and Reporting

As the year is beginning to wind down, teachers are undertaking assessment tasks in preparation for your student's end of year report. Classrooms have been busy places with all students currently being assessed on the outcomes that they have been expected to achieve throughout the

year. Assessment will take the form of class tests, standardised tests, ongoing work samples and informal and formal observations. Reports are due to go home to parents on Friday, 14th December.

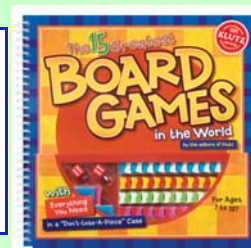
Kindergarten and Stage I News

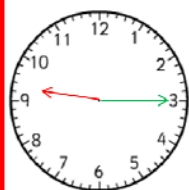

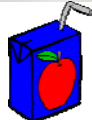
