We will not tolerate, at any time, students who disregard our school rules. Therefore, all Year 6 students have been warned that if they receive a green slip for misbehaviour and disrespect within the next 4 weeks, THEY WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM THE YEAR 6 FAREWELL CELEBRATIONS.

It is very unfortunate that we have had to impose these measures, however, disrespect at school will not be tolerated.

Please discuss with your child the guidelines below for demonstrating respect.

WHAT IS RESPECT?

Respect is showing regard and appreciation for the worth of someone or something. It means honour and esteem. It includes respect for self, respect for the rights and dignity of all persons, and respect for the environment.

- * Raising their hands before talking
- * Saying "please" and "thank you"






