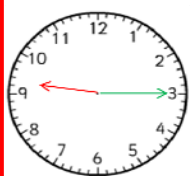
Super 8's Cricket

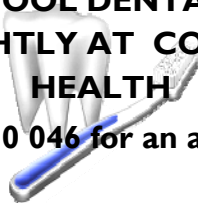

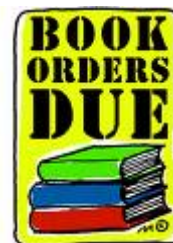
