

University NSW Competitions - ICAS

Students are invited to enter the University of NSW competitions for 2012. Students are required to pay an entry fee and upon completion of the test they will receive a detailed report and a certificate of achievement. The competition is open to students all over Australia, New Zealand, Asia and the Pacific regions.

ICAS reports provide more than just information on how individual students perform; schools receive an in-depth report on each year group indicating strengths and weaknesses, comparisons to state grade averages and tracking of year level progress from one year to the next.

Participation in ICAS provides students with valuable practice at sitting formal examinations, preparing them for compulsory state-based assessments, assisting them to become more comfortable in answering questions and managing their time effectively under exam conditions.
