

PSP Surveys

Hay PS is applying for NSW Government Priority Schools Programme Funding (PSP) in March. To be successful the school needs the help of every one of its families. PSP funding provides much needed additional assistance (approximately \$50,000 cash each year for four years). This funding can support additional staff and staff support for disadvantaged schools Surveys are anonymous and can help fund programs in literacy, completely confidential numeracy, and learning support. It can help to enrich the education of students in a disadvantaged environment and help close the gap between advantaged and disadvantaged schools.

The recent drought has left Hay a relatively disadvantaged community and disadvantage is reflected in our schools' populations. To be successful in securing PSP funds, the school must survey each school family to get an accurate picture of our relative disadvantage during the week 5th March to 9th March 2012 and we must receive the surveys back from each school family. If this happens, we believe that we will be successful in our PSP application.

The School will be providing assistance for anyone having difficulty completing the survey and entry into a \$150 grocery voucher prize at IGA is being offered as an Carol Oataway incentive for completing the survey.
