Winners of the individual championships were: Junior Boy - Brait Headon; Junior Girl - Lillian Ives, Emily Headon, Delilah Crighton (three way tie); 11 Years Boy - Kynan Headon; 11 Years Girl - Grace Nisbet; Senior Boy - Jack Loveridge; and Senior Girl - Lauren Mijok. Kynan Headon broke three, long standing records (over 40 years old) on the day being: 11 years Boys 200m - 28.34 (J Howard - 1992); 11 years Boys 100m - 13.69 (K Finch - 1971); and Boys' Senior Championship 100m - 13.72 (K Thompson - 1971). 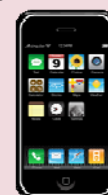
