A common sense approach also needs to be adopted and children under the age of eight really do need adult supervision Athletics when walking to and from school to keep them safe. Parents should work with children to build up their **Excursions** independence, while walking to school, through route finding, road safety skills


Lollipop Lady Extraordinaire
