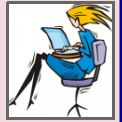
Father's Day Stall

\$2.00 needs to be paid to Tim Hanns on the day.

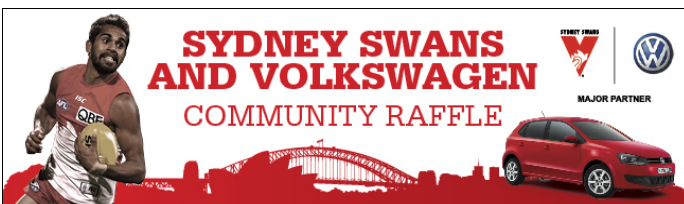

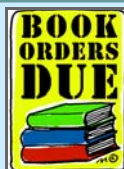

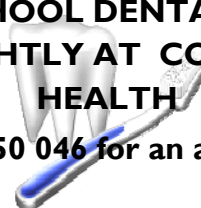
