Raising Difficult Children

Dr Peter Powell, the co-author of the book *Raising Difficult Children* will be visiting Hay in early 2013 and is available for private consultation with parents. This service has been provided through the Department of Health and Aging. The book raises the issue of parenting children with ADHD and Oppositional Defiance Disorder and looks into the trials and tribulations of parenting. If you are interested in obtaining a consultation

with Dr Peter Powell, you will need to be referred by your GP and the service is covered under Medicare. The school currently has forms for you to complete if interested. Please contact Mrs Jo Dunn at the front office to obtain the correct claim form.

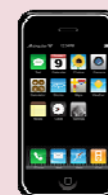

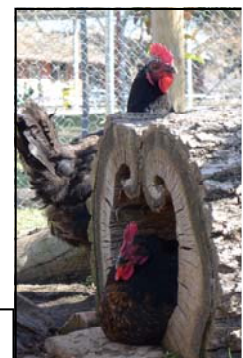

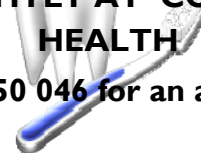
