All staff have been working hard over the summer holidays preparing for the school year, ensuring a quality learning and teaching environment for students to be successful.

This year we will continue to implement Accelerated

Students will be divided into six groups according to their competency and understanding of numeracy. Movement within the groups will occur throughout the year as students complete various assessments.
