### **Principal's Report**

#### NAPLAN

NAPLAN testing will occur between the dates  $14^{th} - 16^{th}$  May for students in Years 3 and Year 5. Students will complete language and writing tests on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> May, reading tests on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> May and numeracy tests on Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May. Any students who miss tests will have the opportunity to catch up on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May. Results of these tests should be Lost Property available in September.

#### Uniform

Thank you to parents who are making a special effort to ensure that students are coming to school dressed in their correct school uniform. As the weather is starting to cool down, students should be wearing their Winter uniform which is long, grey pants for the boys and long sleeved blue shirts. The girls' Winter uniform is the Navy tunic with a white, long sleeved shirt. All students are to wear




#### Sport

### STAGE II


