Principal's Report

This week students and teachers will be focusing on the value of COOPERATION. Cooperation in school and within the classroom means working together to achieve common goals, providing support to others, and engaging in peaceful resolution of conflict.

In classrooms, evidence of this value includes:

This year all students from Kinder to Year 6 have been encouraged to participate in the Premier's Reading Challenge. This challenge involves students reading 20 books during the time frame of the challenge. 15 of these are from the book list put out by the Premier's department and 5 other books can be selected by the

student. Students from Kinder to Year 2 are participating in the challenge during Library each week and are well on their way to completing it. Stage 2 and 3 students have a selection of challenge books provided in their classrooms and read daily to complete their quota.

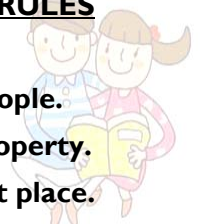

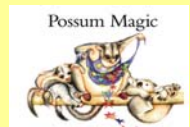

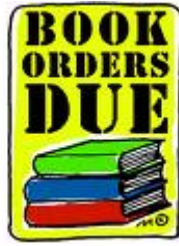
