Once again Hay Public School will implement an extended Kindergarten transition program in 2013 called **Ready, Set, Kinder**. Children will access a variety of opportunities which will enhance their developing skills and prepare them for school life at Hay Public School in 2014.

All students entering Kindergarten at Hay Public School in 2014 are invited to participate in our **'Ready, Set, Kinder!'** prior to school education program each Wednesday from 9:15 am to 3:00 pm in Terms 3 and 4 to undertake learning and familiarisation activities and to experience aspects of school life.
