



Stage 2 & 3 News

On behalf of the Stage 2 and 3 staff I would like to welcome everyone to the 2014 school year. I extend also a very warm welcome to our new families. I am excited for the opportunities that await your children this year. All staff have been working hard over the summer holidays preparing for the school year, ensuring a quality learning and teaching environment for students to be successful.

We welcome to Stage 2, Mrs Sarah Houston and Mr Robert Fajks and to Stage 3, Mrs Fleur Cullenward and Miss Kate Burke. Welcome back to Mrs Sherelle Shea, Mrs Jayne Rutledge, Mrs Robyn Pearson and Mrs Dannielle Christensen. We are very fortunate to have such experienced and enthusiastic staff in Stage 2 and 3 this year.

This year we will implement the new NSW English syllabus through the pedagogy of Accelerated Literacy. Maths groups will begin Week 4 and these will focus on numeracy concepts and problem solving strategies and run over three days (Mon, Tues, Wed). Students will be divided into groups according to their competency and understanding of numeracy. Movement within the groups will occur throughout the year as students complete



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various assessments.

All classes will participate in Library, Computer Technology and Kitchen Garden. Please refer to your child's timetable for specific times.

Home Reading is a very important part of a child's learning. We will be encouraging all students to participate in home reading each night. Each child will be given a reading journal and folder and teachers will regularly check that these outcomes are being met.

Our discipline policy provides a positive focus to encourage desirable student behaviours. The expectations promote and embrace the core values of public education:-

RESPECT, RESPONSIBILTY, INTEGRITY, COOPERATION, CARE, DEMOCRACY, EXCELLENCE, PARTICIPATION AND FAIRNESS. It is based on the philosophy that teachers have a right to teach and students have a right to learn. All teachers use assertive discipline strategies to ensure optimal intellectual, social, emotional and physical success for all students.

Excursions- Stage 3 excursion this year is to Bendigo and Ballarat. It will be in Week 10, Term 3. Further information regarding payment will be sent home early this term.


School Banking Day Reminder
