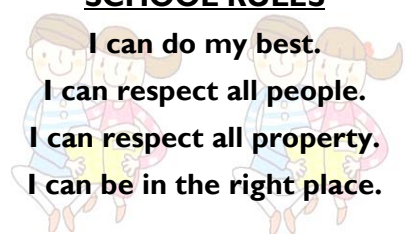

Discipline Policy

Throughout this term, the school community has reviewed and revised the school discipline policy to ensure that it is still current and relevant for the students of Hay Public School. A copy of the school's discipline policy has been published on the school website for your reference. Underpinning this policy are the school's four rules:

I can do my best;

I can respect all property;

I can respect all people; and

I can be in the right place.

These rules ensure that students have a right to learn, teachers have a right to teach and all parties remain safe in doing so. I am more than happy to explain and discuss any aspect of our discipline policy at any time.

Assessments and Reports

The teachers at Hay PS have been very busy over the past few weeks collecting assessment data and beginning the process of writing student reports. They are pleased with the progress each student has made and look forward to celebrating their achievements. Reports will go home on Friday 20th June, with Parent Teacher Interviews taking place the following week during Week 9. The

midyear report will give each child a grade for each key learning area, as well as an assessment of each child's effort in class. A **sound** grade means that your child is achieving outcomes expected of them at this point in time. Anything above or below this grade means exactly that; that they are above grade expectations or below grade expectations. The midyear report will include a general comment with more detailed information to be discussed at scheduled parent / teacher interviews. Interview schedules will be included in next week's newsletter. This will be a great opportunity to meet with your child's teacher and discuss any concerns you may have.

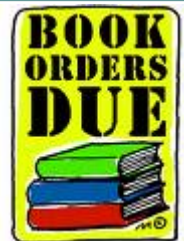
