**School Banking Day****Reminder**

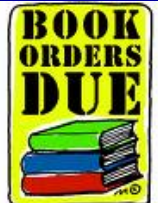
Don't forget that Monday is School Banking Day and students should bring in their weekly deposit **to the front office first thing in the morning.**
