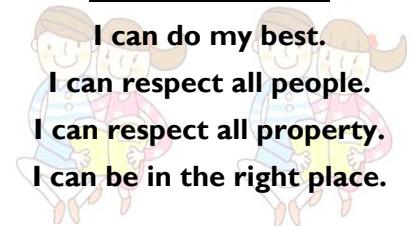

## Kindergarten Excursion- Altina Wildlife Park

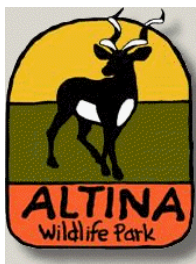

## Stage 2 and 3 News

### School Rule : I CAN BE IN TH RIGHT PLACE.

Parents are reminded that supervision does not start until 8.45am each school day. If students arrive before this time they are asked to sit quietly on the verandah. This is to ensure their safety and the safety of others. There have been an increasingly large number of students arriving before this time and playing soccer, riding skateboards etc. By doing so they are putting themselves and other students at risk of harm. Please remind your child to sit quietly on the verandah until the bell goes.

We have also been experiencing unruly behaviour in the bus lines. **ALL students** are reminded to sit quietly in their bus lines while waiting for their bus. The teacher on bus duty will ensure all students walk quietly in their lines toward their bus when it arrives.

Students are reminded that by breaching these behaviours they are breaking our school rule of **I can be in the right place**. These concerns have been discussed with students and consequences will apply if this behaviour continues.


