Principal's Report

Remembrance Day

Remembrance Day in Australia is dedicated to Australians who died as a result of war, particularly from World War I onwards. A minute of silence is dedicated to the deceased, especially for soldiers who died fighting to protect the nation. Red poppies are worn on Remembrance Day to remember those who died during war. Poppies were among the first plants that came from the battlefields of northern France and Belgium during World War I. Pictured are our captains, Hannah Shea, Tom Christensen, Lily Masters and Hugh Duncan when they attended the wreath laying ceremony at the cenotaph to commemorate Remembrance Day.

Instructional Leader Literacy-Numeracy

Recently the school received an additional staffing allocation of 3 days per week to employ a Deputy Principal as an Instructional Leader. I am pleased to announce that Mrs Suzanne Murphy has been successful in obtaining this position and will commence in 2017. The position will be in the school until the end of 2019 and possibly into 2020. As part of her role, Mrs Murphy will be working with K-2 teachers to improve their teaching practice in the areas of literacy and numeracy and will assist them in tracking each and every student to ensure they are reaching the required benchmarks.

Parliamentarian Nominations

Nominations opened on Monday for the positions of student leaders in 2017. Students from Year 5 are eligible to stand for election if they have demonstrated good conduct, are excellent role models to other

students and uphold the traditions of Hay Public School (eg, wear the correct school uniform on a daily basis). Nomination forms are available from the front office and are to be handed in by Friday 18th November. After nominations are confirmed, speeches and elections will be held to elect twelve parliamentarians for our school. Speeches and voting for parliamentarians will take place on Monday 28th November.

Year 6 Behaviour

Unfortunately the behaviour of Year 6 students lately has been less than satisfactory. Students are of the opinion that they have nearly completed their primary school education and they are too mature to be at school and are above the rules of the school. Please note that the school **expects** students to treat others with respect, teachers with respect and to do as they are told. This ensures the safety of all students and allows students to learn in the classroom. There will be zero tolerance for outspoken disrespect towards teachers and teachers' aides. Preparations are underway for the Year 6 Farewell and students will only be invited if their behaviour is satisfactory. The school will not be farewelling students who blatantly defy teachers. This event is a privilege, not a right. I expect that all students in Year 6 will heed this advice and choose their attitude and their behaviour more carefully in the future.
