## Resilience

One common trait all successful adults have is resilience. This is the ability to bounce back from disappointment and is something that needs to be taught to our kids every day. As our kids constantly remind us, life isn't always fair. How do we balance the desire to protect our children with the need to teach them how to cope with life's disappointments? Children will succeed if you let them sort problems out for themselves and if you refrain from constantly stepping in to save them from failure. Teach your child how to interact effectively with their peers, teach them that life isn't always fair and to accept that and adapt. Talk to them, commend their strengths and be positive about their abilities to improve their other skills. Kids notice how well parents handle stress and challenges and copy these behaviours. Get your children involved in extra curricular activities to help develop their social skills.

Just a reminder that March 30th is the absolute last day that entries will be accepted into the UNSW competitions. Entry forms and costs have been included in Hay Happenings over the past seven weeks. Competitions are Australia wide and extend to Asia and the Pacific and are held in a variety of subjects.
