ANZAC Day

NAPLAN

NAPLAN testing will occur between the dates 10th– 13th May for students in Year 3 and Year 5. Students will complete language and writing tests on Tuesday 10th May, reading tests on Wednesday 12th May and numeracy tests on Thursday 13th May. Any students who miss tests will have the opportunity to catch up on Friday 15th May. Results of these tests should be available in September.

Yesterday our teachers were involved in professional learning day and over the course of the day, teachers familiarised themselves with the writing aspect of the literacy continuum and completed mandatory training in emergency care.

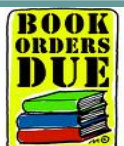
Stewart House Day -Friday 6th May
