Principal's Report

Attendance

Attendance at school is most important and any student enrolled in a NSW school is required to attend school each day it is open for instruction. Principals are legally responsible for maintaining accurate records of student attendance. When reasons for absences are provided to the school by parents, principals are accountable for their decision to record a student's absence as justified. Principals may decline to accept as satisfactory an explanation for an absence and will record that absence as unjustified. Principals may also request medical certificates if

illness occurs frequently or is prolonged. It is the responsibility of parents or carers to make sure that their children attend school each day. It is important to understand that parents (including carers) may be prosecuted if children of compulsory school age have recurring numbers of unjustified absences from school. The Principal will be conducting an audit of absences this week and will be notifying parents by letter if there are any concerns.

NAPLAN

This week our Year 3 and 5 students sit their NAPLAN tests. NAPLAN is a national test that all students across Australia sit annually. It is designed to test skills that are essential for every child to progress through school and life, such as reading, writing, spelling and numeracy. Results are used by teachers to identify students who require greater challenges or additional support and to set goals in literacy and numeracy.

Children are encouraged to have early nights and a good breakfast so that they are able to concentrate throughout the testing period.


