### Principal's Report

**MAKE ONLINE PAYMENTS** Accessible now - parents are now able to make online payments to the school for amounts owing for students, via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the schools website by selecting \$ **Make a payment**. Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, subject contributions, excursions, sales to students. There is also a category called 'Other' which covers items not covered in the previous headings. 'Other' can be used to make a complete payment of a school invoice. Please remember to include a payment description if utilising the online payment option.

### Reporting

Reports are due to go home next Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June. They give a snapshot of the educational progress that your child has made over the past semester, as well as their social development and commitment to learning. Teachers assess students at Hay Public School against state wide standards and use a rigorous assessment process in order to do so.

In addition to written reports we encourage parents and caregivers to attend scheduled parent / teacher meetings. This is a worthwhile opportunity where parents and teachers can share important information about their child's talents, strengths, interests and needs. All parents are encouraged to attend these meetings and be involved in your child's learning, as it is important to maintain strong communication lines between home and school. Parents / Teacher meetings are scheduled for Week 10. If you are

unable to attend on the given day, please ring the school to make alternative arrangements.

### Supporting Children's Friendship Skills

Parents, carers and school staff have important roles to play in helping children develop positive friendships. Adults can set examples for children to follow through the ways they manage relationships. They can teach children helpful social skills and talk through friendship issues to help with solving problems. As they learn how to manage social situations, having opportunities to talk about friendships with parents and staff helps children feel supported and develops communication skills.

This week we farewell Mrs Felicity Maynard from our school. Mrs Maynard has been instrumental in implementing the Kitchen Garden program, providing a pleasurable food education that has taught our students to grow fresh seasonal produce and use it to prepare nutritious, delicious food. 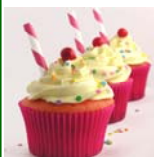

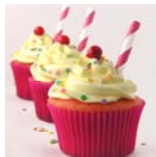
