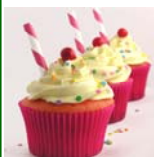
Seth Stoltenberg the Rugby Development Officer for Southern Inland will be running the session. Participants will be taught fun skills that can be used in all sports.

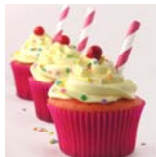
