Principal's Report

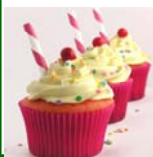

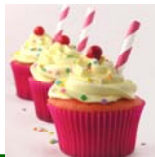

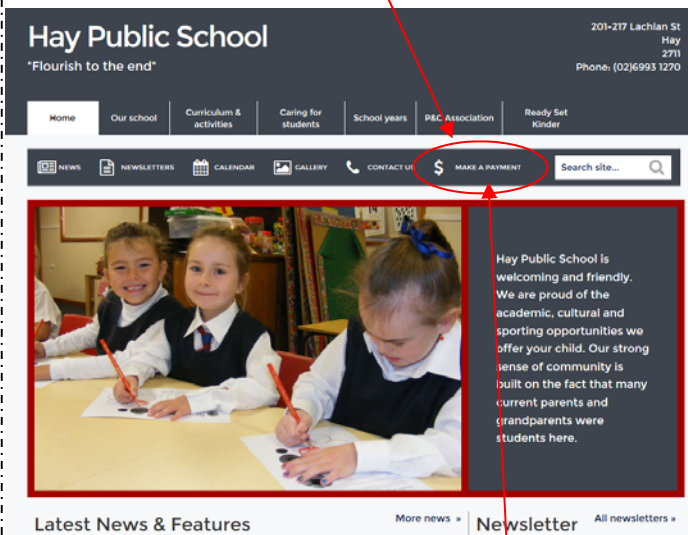
