Principal's Report

NAPLAN

Good luck to all of our Year 3 and Year 5 students who will be sitting their NAPLAN tests next week. Tests are conducted in Writing and Language Conventions on Tuesday, Reading on Wednesday and Mathematics on Thursday. Children are encouraged to have early nights and a good breakfast each morning so that they are able to concentrate throughout the testing period. This is the best preparation that children can have for their tests.

Attendance

Attendance at school is most important and any student enrolled in a NSW school is required to attend school each day it is open for instruction. Principals are legally responsible for maintaining accurate records of student attendance. When reasons for absences are provided to the school by parents, principals are accountable for their decision to record a student's absence as justified. Principals may decline to accept as satisfactory an explanation for an absence and will record that absence as unjustified. Principals may also request medical certificates if illness occurs frequently or is prolonged. It is the responsibility of parents or carers to make sure that their children attend school each day. It is important to understand that parents (including carers) may be prosecuted if children of compulsory school age have recurring numbers of unjustified

absences from school. The Principal and the Home School Liaison Officer will be conducting an audit of absences this week and will be notifying parents by letter if there are any concerns.

Winter Uniform

The weather at the moment is very changeable. Students are asked to wear their winter uniforms to school so that they remain warm at all times. The girls' winter uniform includes a navy tunic, white blouse, school jumper, navy tights and black shoes. The boys' uniform includes long grey pants, blue shirts, school jumpers, grey socks and black shoes. Ties are optional for all.

Cross Country

The school's annual cross country will be held this Thursday at the Hay Park Oval. Students who are turning 8 and over will be participating in this event. Events include: 8 and 9 years (2km), 10 years (2 km), 11 years (3km), 12 and 13 years (3km). Please come along to support our students. Parents are welcome to assist with the event, be a supporter or if feeling energetic, can even run / walk the course.

Rugby Union Trials– Jubilee Park, Wagga

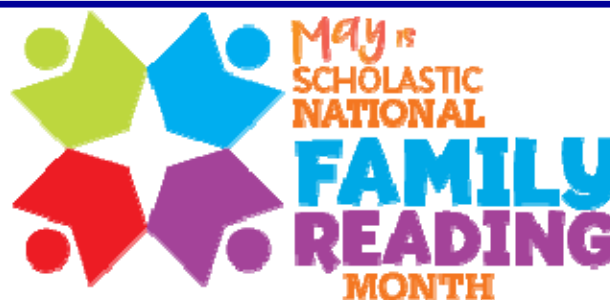
