Hay Public School is seeking enrolments in its Ready Set Kinder program for students commencing school in 2018. Ready Set Kinder is an initiative of Hay Public School that has been running since 2009. It provides prospective Kindergarten students a chance to enrol in a quality, educational program, delivered by an experienced early childhood trained teacher. The program runs over two terms and students experience life at their new school for one full day per week (Wednesdays). Throughout the course of the day, students learn to socialise, meet new friends, engage in literacy, language, numeracy, creative and performing arts programs and learn the necessary routines of a school day. 
