Principal's Report

GRIP Leadership Conference

Last week our school captains and parliamentarians attended a leadership training day in Griffith. The day was run by GRIP Leadership, an independent organisation that exists to train and develop leaders. The day focused on the following areas – *How to Grow as a Leader, Bye Bye Bullying, People to Influence and Traffic Light Leadership*. These practical workshops have given our students the knowledge and skills to positively influence younger students, their peers and teachers and to establish core values to continually learn and grow. Our school leaders will implement their newfound skills and goals to develop a vision for the future of our school and indeed their own life journey. Thank you to Mrs Cullenward for supporting this opportunity for our student leaders.

Positive Social Skills

Children who are good at making and keeping friends use positive social skills. Parents, carers and staff help children learn positive social skills by guiding them as young children, being positive examples for children to follow and providing opportunities for play where children can practise their skills. Key social skills that help with friendships include cooperation, communication, empathy, emotional control and responsibility. All children go through friendship conflicts at some stage of their schooling. Encourage and discuss with your child some positive social skills and behaviours to use when this occurs – taking turns, asking questions, refusing to join in negative behaviours, following the rules of the game, cooperating and playing fair.

Parliament Fundraising

This Thursday our parliamentarians will be holding a Footy Colours Day to raise money for the Year 6 gift to the school. Students are asked to come dressed in the colours of their favourite football team whether it is in rugby league, AFL, rugby or soccer.

Assessments and Reports

The teachers at Hay PS have been very busy over the past few weeks collecting assessment data and beginning the process of writing student reports. They are pleased with the progress each student has made and look forward to celebrating their achievements. Reports will go home on Friday 23rd June, with Parent Teacher Interviews taking place the following week during Week 10. The mid-year report will give each child a grade for each key learning area, as well as an assessment of each child's effort in class. The descriptors of learning used in our reports are self-explanatory describing where each student is in relation to their grade expectation. I urge all parents to attend these interviews as they are a part of our reporting process, as well as a great opportunity to meet with your child's teacher and discuss any concerns you may have.
