Principal's Report New Finance System

Hay Public School will transition to the new NSW public schools' finance system and a new bank account on 24 July 2017. To ensure a smooth transition, there will be changes to the way we accept parent or carer payments. We can no longer accept direct deposits into our current school bank account as we prepare to close this account and transition to the new one. Cheque and cash payments will temporarily cease at the end of Term 2, Friday 30 June 2017 as we prepare to close our current bank account and transition to the new one. Please ensure that issues through the school's discipline policy. Parents should not you have made any outstanding cash or cheque payments before close of business on 30 June 2017. From 25 July 2017, cash and cheque payments will be accepted as before. We will be unable to accept online payments between 1 July 2017 and 24 July 2017. Parent Online Payments (POP) will resume, as before from 25 July 2017. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we transition to our new finance system. Learning builds confidence and a child who is confident is more open to new opportunities to learn. Talk positively about the importance of education with your child. Let your child see how much you enjoy and value learning and remember, it's ok if you don't have all the answers to your child's questions, but it's beautiful thing about learning is that nobody can take it away from you.
