Principal's Report

Athletics Carnival

Congratulations to Oxley House who were declared overall winners of our Athletics Carnival, held last Friday. The day ran perfectly with great participation from all students. Our age champions were: **Junior** – Matilda Nisbet, Dan Jamieson; **11 years** – Emily Cai, Nathaniel Clarke; **12/13 years** – Isobella Murray, Jim Houston. One record was broken on the day when Nathaniel Clarke bettered the previous 11 years 800m record held by Jett Nawrotzski and Jim Houston equalled Brait Headon's senior boy high jump record. The District carnival is due to be held in Deniliquin on 12th August. Stage 1 students also had a successful day with Oxley House taking out the annual Jellybean Cup. Thank you to Mrs Houston and Mrs Shea for their expert organisation on the day.

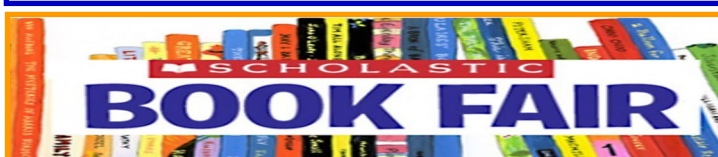

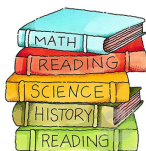
HPS CANTEEN NEWS
