### Principal's Report

#### Uniform

Thank you to all students who are making an effort to wear their correct school, summer uniform. Many favourable comments have been received from members of the public about how smart our students are looking in their summer uniforms. The Hay Public School Uniform Policy states clearly that the official summer uniform is either the blue dress, white socks and black shoes or the blue button up shirt, grey shorts, grey socks and black shoes. The School Council and P&C do not endorse any variations to these uniforms and encourage all students to be dressed in the official Hay Public School uniform. All students are also required to wear a school, sun-safe hat at all times during play. As the weather is cooling down, jumpers are optional to wear with the summer uniform. Navy jumpers with a school logo are the P&C endorsed option. Hats, jumpers and vests are available from the front office and pre-loved uniforms are available from the school canteen.

#### Extra Commitments

It is that time of year again when students in Stage 3 have constant demands on their time with the extra sporting activities that the school and district have on offer. As a consequence, students need to be conscientious in making up for lost time in the classroom by doing extra homework and making it their business to ask about work that needs to be caught up. Parents need to be mindful of the amount of activities that their children are involved in and make their own judgements about the impact it is having on their child's education.

#### Life Education

At the end of this term the Life Education Van will be visiting the school to provide lessons in a healthy lifestyle to our students. Students are asked to pay \$10 to access this program, which includes a lesson in the Life Education Van and a booklet for

follow-up lessons and activities in the classroom. The Life Education Van is a curriculum based program empowering children to make safe and healthy lifestyle choices now and into their adult lives. Please ensure that you make a payment to the front office to ensure that your child accesses all resources around this program.

#### Visitors to the School

All visitors to the school must enter via the front office to sign the visitor's book. This ensures that we are following our workplace safety guidelines and know about all persons who are entering onto our school site. Anyone who volunteers at our school is required to provide their volunteer's Working With Children Check clearance, 100 points of identification and must sign declarations that they have no convictions around child protection. This also applies to volunteer parents who transport other students to sporting events. Assistance in providing this can be given via the front office.

#### P&C Membership

All classes have now been contacted regarding membership to the P&C and the benefits it brings to your child and to yourself. All new families to the school have also been contacted by mail. Please consider this carefully and contact your child's class teacher if you are willing to represent your child's class and attend meetings each month. The next meeting is on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> April at 2pm in the school staffroom.

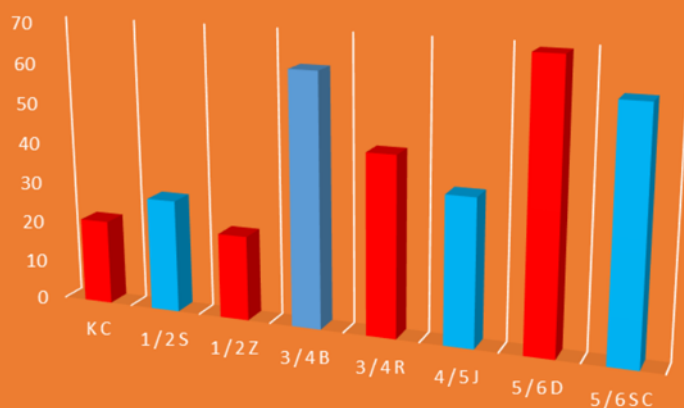
