Principal's Report

Athletics Carnival

On Friday the school will hold its annual athletics carnival at the Hay Park oval. All students, K-6, will be involved and we are expecting a successful day full of participation and fun. Students will walk to the oval in their house groups and the carnival will commence with a march past. Students are asked to dress in their house colours, showing support for their team. This year, a new event, a 1500m race, will be included in the program. This will be by invitation only to those students who are capable of running this distance. A canteen will be operating on the grounds and Mrs Hurle, our canteen supervisor, is seeking donations of cakes, slices and biscuits to be sold on the day. Volunteers are also needed to help serve in the canteen. All parents, grandparents, extended family and community members are invited to the oval this Friday to cheer for our students.




