Principal's Report

District Swimming Carnival

Congratulations to Hay Public School who was placed second to the champion school, Deniliquin South Public School, at the Deniliquin District Swimming Carnival last Friday. Our swimmers all swam beautifully, many performing with personal best times. Matilda Nisbet broke a long-standing record of 20 years, recording a lightning fast time of 45.29s in the 11 Years Girls' Breaststroke. Poppy Barnes was awarded the Junior Girls' individual championship on the day and sixteen swimmers have qualified for the Riverina Regional Swimming Carnival to be held in Albury on 11th March. These

swimmers have been working hard over the past few months with regular training sessions over the Christmas holidays and throughout the term. It is great to see that effort and perseverance has reaped rewards.
