Principal's Report

Return to School

The NSW Government is preparing for all children to return to school with an increase in face-to-face teaching in Term 2.

From May 11 (Week 3), the school will transition in to Phase I where all students will be asked to attend school one day per week. This will occur in a staged way based on your child's House group. Students are asked to attend school next week as follows:

Monday - COBB

Tuesday – OXLEY

Wednesday – STURT

Thursday – CADELL

Friday – School will be open for children who need to be at school.

The school canteen will be open from May 11 with preorders available for lunch and recess. Students will not be lining up at the canteen and orders will be delivered to each classroom.
