Principal's Report

Easing of Restrictions

In line with health advice, schools are operating full time, and many additional activities are now able to recommence. From last Monday, schools are permitted to run 15 minute sailing. assemblies, choir and performing arts. External providers are allowed back into the school environment such as skills to cope with these times, to problem solve and build occupational therapists, speech therapists and music / dance resilience. In essence, we need to step out of the way, allow teachers. School photos are allowed, along with day trips from school. Parents, volunteers and visitors are still restricted from entering the school site and can only do so via the front office. Further easing of restrictions will commence from Term 3, including competition sport, interschool activities (eg debating, public speaking), P&C meetings and external providers being allowed to use school facilities.

Reporting to Parents

Reports will go home on Friday 7th August, with parentteacher interviews being conducted via phone this year. The classroom teachers will be contacting parents after reports are sent home to arrange a mutually convenient time to discuss their child's growth, development and achievement in office and have their name and contact details registered. learning this year.

Assemblies

Assemblies are taking place weekly via ZOOM. At this stage Hand hygiene and physical distancing remain most important. parents and guests are still not able to attend the school site Stay well and stay safe. and assemblies greater than 15 minutes cannot take place.

Building Resilience in Children

There are times as parents where we want to step in and make everything right in the world for our children. We don't

like to see our children experience sadness, anxiety, emotional pain, friendship problems, being disciplined at school or struggling to overcome a problem. Our natural instinct is to try and smooth the path for our children to make their lives 'easier' and 'happier'. The reality is life is not always smooth There are times in our life when things will be challenging and we need to give our children the necessary our children to fail, make mistakes and then assist them through the resolution in a safe, loving and supportive environment. It is not what you do for your children, but what you have taught them to do for themselves that will make them successful human beings.

Health Advice

We continue to work around the latest health advice which states that school is safe for children but restrictions need to be placed on the number of adults allowed on school site. For this reason parents are asked to farewell and collect their children from behind the school gate and not enter classrooms. All adults on site are asked to report to the front Please follow all health advice and keep your child at home if they are unwell or have a respiratory illness.
