Congratulations to the Hay Public School swim team who were declared overall champions on the day at the Deniliquin District Our swimmers all swam Swimming Carnival last Friday. beautifully, many performing with personal best times. Matilda Nisbet broke a long-standing record of 12 years, recording a lightning fast time of 42.22s in the 12/13 Years Girls' 50m Breaststroke. Matilda is now the proud holder of all three District breaststroke records. Marley Sorensen was awarded equal Junior Girl champion, Alex Giddins the Junior Boy champion and Poppy Barnes the 11 Year Girls' champion on the Attendance day. Seventeen swimmers have qualified for the Riverina Regional Swimming Carnival to be held in Leeton on 10th March. These swimmers have been working hard over the past few months with regular training sessions over the Christmas holidays and perseverance has reaped rewards.
